

## ***SHORT CURRICULUM VITAE OF PAOLO MACCARRONE***

Paolo Maccarrone is Associate Professor at Politecnico di Milano, where he teaches *Accounting, Finance and Control* at the M.Sc. in Management Engineering. He is also member of the core Faculty of MIP Graduate School of Business, where he teaches *Accounting, Control and Performance Management* and *CSR/Sustainability Strategic Management* in many MBA/Executive MBA and Corporate Executive Programs. He also Head of the Accounting, Control and Performance Management teaching area. At Politecnico di Milano he was also member of the Board of the Department of Management, Economics and Industrial Engineering and Director of the Applied Research Center on Information Security Management. At MIP he was member of the Executive Committee (with the role of Deputy Dean for alumni relations), Director of the Executive MBA (both in Milan and in Rome), of the MBA Part Time and of the portfolio of short training courses on Strategic Sustainability Management.

He graduated *summa cum laude* in Management Engineering (at Politecnico di Milano), and he then got a Ph.D. in Management Engineering at University of Padova.

His research interests can be grouped into two main fields:

- Management Accounting and Control, with particular regard to the design of management control systems in industrial and service companies, extended (or supply chain) performance measurement and management systems and the use of activity-based techniques;
- Corporate (Social) Responsibility and Sustainability, with particular regard to the integration of CSR/sustainability into business strategy and to CSR/sustainability performance measurement systems.

He is author of many publications on books and international scientific journals.
