Andreas Lichtblau und Susanna Wagner are in charge of lichtblau.wagner architekten in Vienna since 1987, in 2011 lichtblau.wagner architekten generalplaner zt gmbh was founded. The key aspects of their work are energy efficient, environmentally friendly construction and development of innovative space-saving solutions in Housing and in numerous built building typologies. Their work is recognized and prized both on domestic and international level, for example with the Chicago Athenaeum Award from the American Institute of Architecture, with two nominations for Mies van der Rohe Award in 2003 and in 2011, the prize Best of Europe 2004, also with the Architekturpreis des Landes Burgenland 2004 and the Architekturpreis des Landes Steiermark 1998.
