He managed a five years research project in collaboration with Volkswagen Group Design entitled “Moving Milano 2010-2015. Urban Mobility Culture associated to EXPO 2015” focused on developing electric concept cars for urban mobility.

Currently he is managing the research project “From Sign to the Shape”, focused on innovative contents and methods for teaching the project representation techniques in the university industrial design courses, funded by FARB - University Fund for Basic Research of Politecnico di Milano.
