Laura Cipriani is currently an adjunct Professor in Urbanism and in Landscape Architecture at Università Iuav di Venezia and at Politecnico di Milano. She also taught at NUS National University Singapore, at Venice International University VIU and at Padova University. Since 2014 she holds the Italian Associate Professorship registration (ANVUR) and was a EU Marie Curie researcher (Assistant Professor level) at the University of Trento (winner of the 7th Framework Programme of the European Union). In 2018 Laura was one of the three finalists for the Urban Kiley Fellowship in Landscape Architecture at Harvard Design School.

The academic, didactic and professional interest deals with research in urban and landscape issues with a strong commitment in adopting a transdisciplinary approach and in pursuing pioneering research through design. Her research interest is currently focused on landscapes of crisis – territories and cities affected by environmental, economic, and social crisis. In the past she dealt with airport and industrial landscapes.

Laura received a Ph.D. in Urbanism in 2008 from IUAV Ph.D. School coordinated by Prof. B. Secchi and Prof. Viganò, a Master's degree (M.Des.) with distinction focused on landscape and urban studies from Harvard University (Graduate School of Design) in 2004 (attended with a grant), and Bachelor and Master's degrees in Architecture with honors from Venice University (IUAV) in 2001.

After collaborating with leading urban-landscape experts such as Carl Steinitz, Marcel Smets, PROAP Italia, in 2008 Laura founded Superlandscape, a urban, landscape and architecture research firm.

Of note, Laura have collaborated with PROAP Italia regarding parks in Libya and she was awarded by an Honorable Mention in the UNESCO International Competition in Montreal, by a mention/selection in the international competition in Toronto at the John H. Daniels Faculty of Architecture, Landscape, and Design of the University of Toronto/Metrolinx, and in 2013 the Piccinato Award selected her as a young urban designer.

She worked on research projects that required spatial and environmental planning and development, extensive on-site investigation, mapping and analysis, alternative scenarios development, planning methods and above all 'research by design'/'design by research' approaches. GIS tools, IT tools, participated collaborative geodesign, new data and cartographies (especially in developing countries) are an integral part of the works on a territorial scale.

Professional activity is supported by a constant commitment in research and teaching.

Her interest is currently focused on landscapes of crisis – landscapes which are affected by several climatic, environmental, and economic state of crisis and which require an holistic approach: from ecological design to resilient planning, from water management in relation to extreme events to water quality issues and sea intrusion phenomena, from rural-urban landscapes to cultural landscapes.

The research projects start from the belief that the landscape is not only an environmental resource but also a factor that can become an economic resource, a major driving force for an alternative development of the territory and its cities. On these topics she has worked in many courses that focused on the lagoon of Palmanova and Bassa Friulana, Polesine and Po Delta River, Venice lagoon and its islands in the North-East of Italy, the Veneto Region urban sprawl, the city of Milan, the Cinque Terre National Park. Abroad she has recently worked in the city of Malacca in Malaysia, Singapore, Montreal, and Toronto.

In the past, her work primarily dealt with the relationship between landscape and infrastructure. She is an expert in sustainable landscape design of airports and industrial sites and she consulted for the Veneto Region on the 'Strategic Plan for Venice airport-city.'

She regularly attends conferences on the topic in academic and professional environments and has published her research in several books: *Fragile lands. Landscapes of crisis and possibilities* (Venice: Università Iuav di Venezia, 2019); *Landscapes of hope. Reclaiming Malacca* (Singapore: NUS, 2018); *Islands of possibilities. Venice and the lagoon city* (Rome: Aracne editrice, 2017); *Rethinking Treviso Airport Urbanism: landscape design strategies from now on* (Rome: Aracne editrice, 2014); *Ecological Airport Urbanism: Airports and Landscapes in the Italian Northeast* (Rome: Aracne editrice, 2014); *Airport Urbanism. Aeroporti low cost e nuovi paesaggi* (Rome: Aracne editrice, 2012); *Padova and the Landscape. Alternative Futures for the Roncagette Park and the Industrial Zone* (Trento: Trento University, 2012); *QUAP. Urban Quality of Industrial Areas* (Treviso: Treviso Province, 2005); *Lisbona. Città dell'inquietudine* (Milan: Unicopli, 2003).

Winner of numerous research fellowships, in 2011 Laura was awarded by the Marie Curie Cofund Fellowship within the European Community Seventh Framework Programme. In 2002 she was awarded by a research grant by the Foundation CARIVE (in collaboration with IUAV University of Venice), which allowed her to graduate with honors in landscape and urban studies at Harvard Design School.
