

## Curriculum Vitae of Pierluigi San Pietro

Born in Italy on August 28, 1964, he graduated in Electronical Engineering at the Politecnico di Milano in 1990 and he received a Ph.D. in Computer Science in 1994 at the same university.

He has been a visiting scholar or professor at the University of California at Santa Barbara, the Japan Advanced Institute of Science and Technology, the Université de Marne-la-vallée (Paris) Ecole Normale Supérieure de Cachan (Paris), and Washington State University (USA), for repeated visits ranging from one month to one year.

His research interests deal with software specification and design, with a focus on rigorous methods of software specification, verification and validation. He is the author of more than seventy research works, published on the most important journals and conferences, such as *ACM Transactions on Software Engineering Methodologies*, *IEEE Trans. on Software Engineering*, *Int. Conference on Software Engineering*, *Theoretical Computer Science*. He is a regular reviewer for the *Mathematical Reviews* of the American Mathematical Society.

He served as a member of the program committee of prestigious international conferences, such as the Conf. on Implementation and Application of Automata, and Compiler Construction. He coordinates national and international research projects, funded by national sources and the European Union.

At Politecnico di Milano, he has been co-Coordinator of the Ph.D. program in Computer Science of the Doctoral School of Information Engineering where he has served for six years as Chair of the Program in Computing Engineering, enrolling 2500 undergraduate and graduate students.

He is a full professor of Software Engineering at Politecnico di Milano.
